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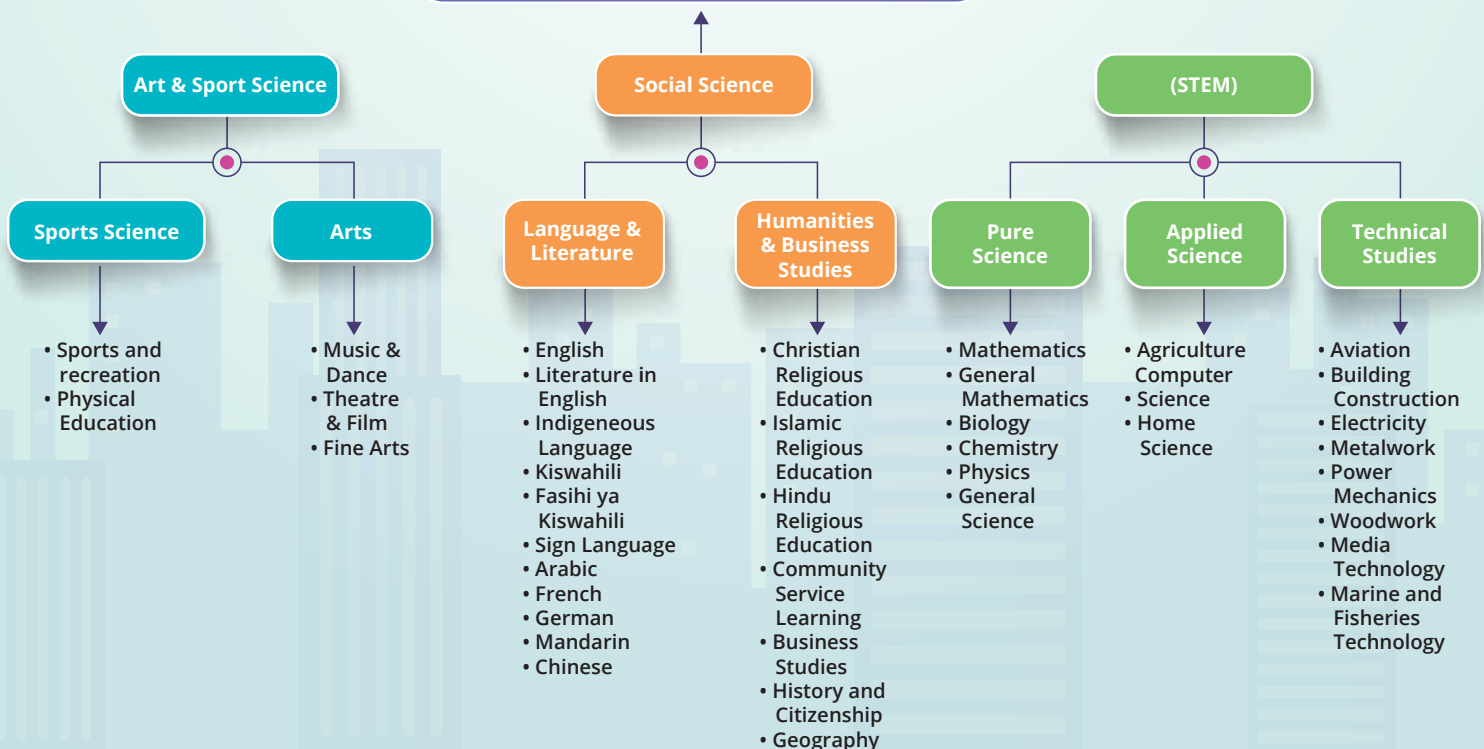
GRADE 10 COURSEBOOKS

Moran Skills in English: Provides a foundation for communication, critical thinking and access to information and knowledge.



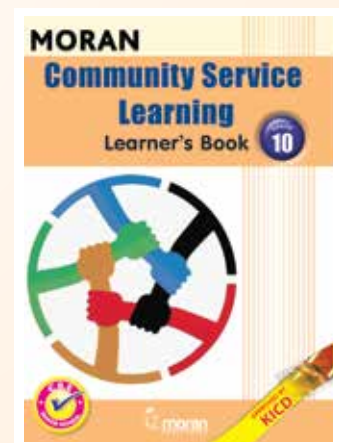
